Requirements to be a Volunteer at Old Richmond

- Live within the Old Richmond Fire District
 - Or within 1 ½ miles of any district line
- Be over the age of 18. (Ages 15 – 18 can apply to be cadet firefighters)
- Be a person with Good Character and in Good Standing with the Community

Process to Become a Volunteer

- Go to our website, www.olderichmondafd.com , and print an application
- Fill the application out and bring it by the station any Thursday night between 7:00 and 9:00 to turn it in to a Membership Committee Member
- Once the Membership Committee receives your application, we will ask that you attend a minimum of three Thursday night meetings to familiarize yourself with us
- During the three weeks you must obtain a copy of your criminal background and turn it into the Membership Committee
- After the three weeks, the Membership Committee will schedule a meeting with you to go over your application, ground rules, and complete the membership process
